\$550 Per person includes:

- Lodging
- All meals on the Ranch
- Basic work project materials
- Helps pay our national staff
- Helps fund our year round programs

\$1,200 - Transportation Includes:

- 10 passenger seating & Luggage
- Airport pick up/drop off
- Driver & Fuel
- For 1-4 additional people there is a 300.00 transportation fee to cover fuel for a second vehicle

Timeline:

- 6 weeks prior to arrival \$275/person is due
- 2 weeks prior to arrival \$275/person is due
- If renting van, \$1,200 is also due 2 weeks prior to arrival
